**I. POLICY**

All department personnel required to wear or maintain a uniform will adhere to the uniform specifications authorized by the Chief of Police and delineated in the Stockton Police Department Uniform Manual. Any request for modifications to existing specifications shall be routed through the Uniform Committee.

**II. PURPOSE**

To designate and standardize the wearing and maintenance of authorized uniforms for Stockton Police Department personnel.

**III. GENERAL TERMS AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

**A. TERMS:**

As used in the uniform manual, the term "Sworn Employee(s)" applies to employees, of the rank of Police Officer or higher rank, to include Reserve Police Officers. The term "Civilian Employee(s)" applies to all other department employees and volunteers, who perform duties other than those of a sworn employee.

**B. TYPES OF UNIFORMS**

Uniforms are divided into five classifications as defined below:

Class "A" Uniform

Dress uniform worn by department personnel with variations based on the member's specialty assignment in Equestrian, Honor Guard, and Motors.

Class "B" Uniform

Working uniform with variations based on the member's primary duty assignment in Air Support, Bikes, Equestrian, Investigations, Motors, and Patrol.

Class "C" Uniform

Alternate to the Class "B" working uniform. The current alternate uniform is the 5.11 brand Patrol Duty Uniform in the Class "A" style.

Class "D" Uniform

Special operational uniform worn while performing duties in the assignments of SWAT, MFF, or EOD.

Class "E" Uniform

Uniform is worn by K-9, Commercial Enforcement, MTU, during regular duties and Motors during training.
