

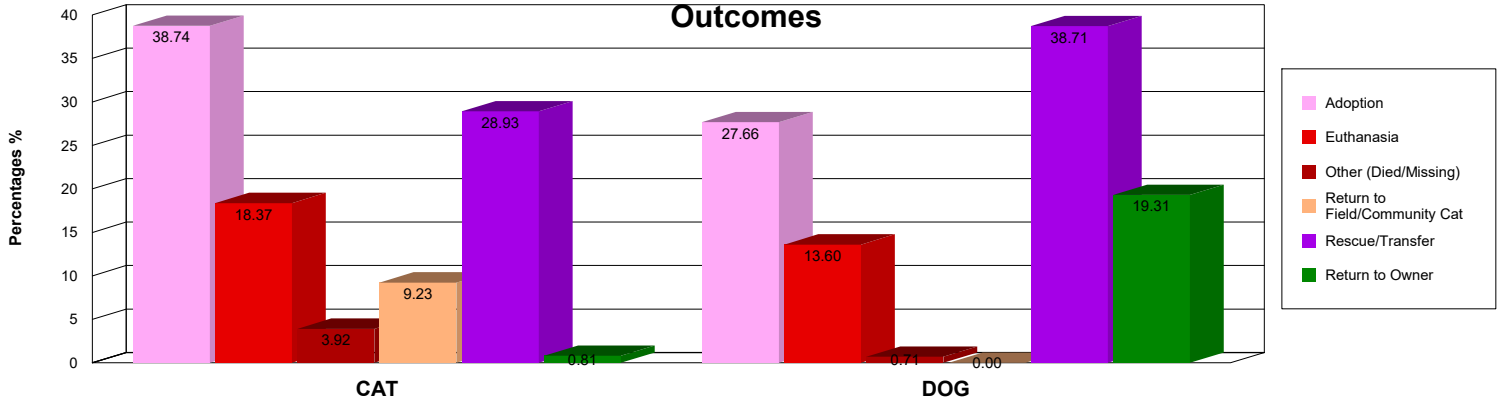

## SUMMARY STATISTICS FOR CAT & DOG Outcomes From 1/1/2018 to 12/31/2018

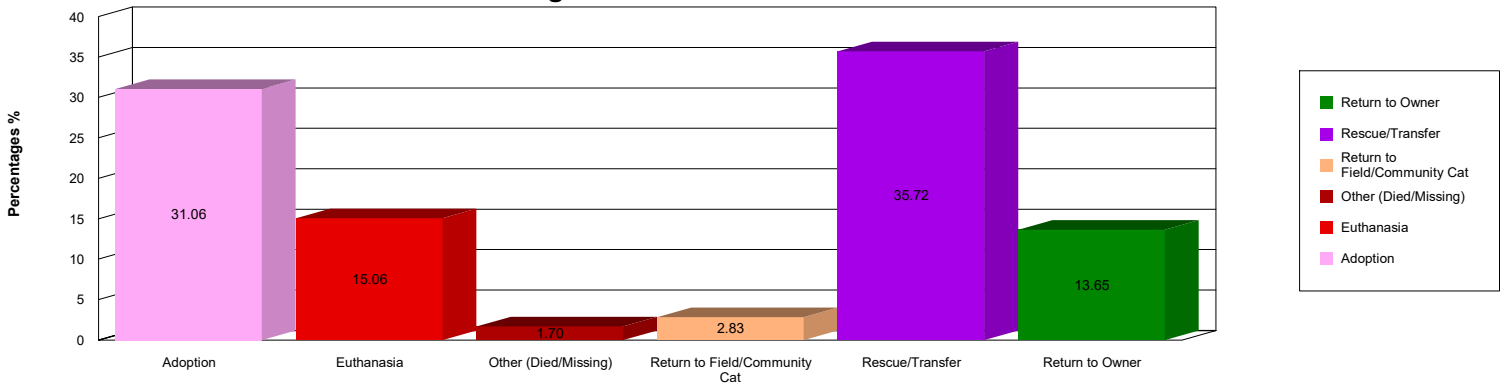
This report shows final outcomes for "at risk" shelter animals only. Excluded are animals arriving deceased and animals coming to the shelter solely for spay/neuter service (or animals with temporary outcomes like "Foster").

In this version of this report animals presenting as "Euthanasia Request" are currently included (but are typically excluded from other "at risk" animal analyses per industry standard definition of "at risk" vs medical service.
